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Learn about Government tenders

Two free events are set to help business people in the Great Southern learn more about tendering for Government contracts.

The Great Southern Development Commission (GSDC) is holding workshops in Albany and Katanning, in partnership with the City of Albany and the Shire of Katanning respectively.

GSDC Chief Executive Officer Bruce Manning said the events are free, but people wishing to attend must register online.

“Government procurement officers will provide guidance and answer questions on the processes,” Mr Manning said.

“People attending will learn how to avoid the common mistakes of tendering and how to make improvements that will make their tenders or quotes more competitive.

“In the current economic climate, many regional businesses will place even greater value on the prospect of gaining work from the Government.”

The first workshop is in Katanning on Wednesday 1 July from 4-6pm. The Albany event is on Thursday 2 July from 3-5.30pm.

The workshops are presented through the Local Content Adviser Network, a state-wide group which includes Charlotte McIntyre, a GSDC-based adviser working to link Great Southern businesses to opportunities in Government works and beyond.
